



COVID Case Study – Yaouré

- Full-scale construction commenced in September quarter 2019
 COVID-19 manifested globally only a few months later
- Construction remains on time and on budget
- How?
 - fewer crew changes (our site people were heroes)
 - changed the way we interact with vendors
 - strict isolation and distancing protocols on site
 - testing
- On track for 'stretch target' of first gold in December 2020, contracted date January 2021
- This success only possible through strong and established relationship, working alongside our client, Perseus Mining, to drive best-for-project outcomes

Joining the Fight Against COVID-19

- We have designed an electrically operated ventilator, known as LycoVent, for use as an emergency backup ventilator
- The portable unit, which is independent of piped oxygen supply, was developed locally in Perth
- We are in the process of applying to the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) under the COVID-19 Emergency Exemption for possible use in Australia
- We also intend to seek the appropriate listing to allow it to be used to support the communities where Lycopodium operates in Africa








An Industry Evolving
